The most essential Kakadu experience at any time of the year. Yellow Water Cruises will take you on a discovery tour of the world-famous Yellow Water Billabong and South Alligator River.

As the sun paints the water's surface with a warm golden glow, the billabong exhibits its basking crocodiles, vibrant birdlife, and the tranquil rhythm of nature.

Guided by knowledgeable locals, the tour unfolds the intricate relationship between local Bininj/Mungguy (Indigenous) people, their culture and the significance of the Ngurrungurrudjba (Yellow Water Billabong) to their existence for 65,000 years.

Tour Notes

Cruise times vary seasonally. Check online or with reception. Please advise staff if you require special assistance.

Dry Season (Apr–Nov)

Meet at the Cooinda Lodge bus stop, opposite reception, 20 minutes before departure.

Wet Season (Dec–Mar)

Meet at Home Billabong, behind Cooinda Lodge next to the boat ramp. Parking is available at the front of the lodge. Follow the marked path from reception.

*The 9:00am cruise operates for 1.5 hours from 1 April 2027.

Operating daily during dry season, itineraries will be subject to group fitness and what attractions are open at the time of the tour. The tour vehicle is fully air-conditioned with lunch included. The tour bus can take up to a maximum of 17 people per vehicle.

- Not suitable for children under 8 years or guests with mobility limitations.
- Cold water, light refreshments and lunch are provided.
- Bring a camera, refillable water bottle, hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, enclosed shoes, swimwear and towel.
- Tour itineraries may vary depending on seasonal conditions and cultural access.

On Murumburr Country and just 1km from Cooinda Lodge, Warradjan Cultural Centre is an interactive museum and community space that shares the history of Aboriginal culture in Kakadu. Curated by the local Bininj/Mungguy people, it showcases traditional artworks, seasonal exhibitions, and offers a place to sit on Country and weave with Bininj artists, and Murumburr Traditional Owners.

Warradjan is the Kundjeyhmi word for the Pig-nosed Turtle, a species native to Kakadu National Park and found in the nearby Ngurrungurrudjba (Yellow Water Billabong). The name is reflected in the centre's distinctive circular design, inspired by traditional gathering places and the storytelling traditions of Bininj/Mungguy people.

As you move through the centre, follow the journey of the Rainbow Serpent Creation Ancestor as it travels across Country—through the lowlands in the dry season and into the stone country during the wet.

Come and sit on Country, listen to our stories, and immerse yourself in the oldest continuous culture in the world.
