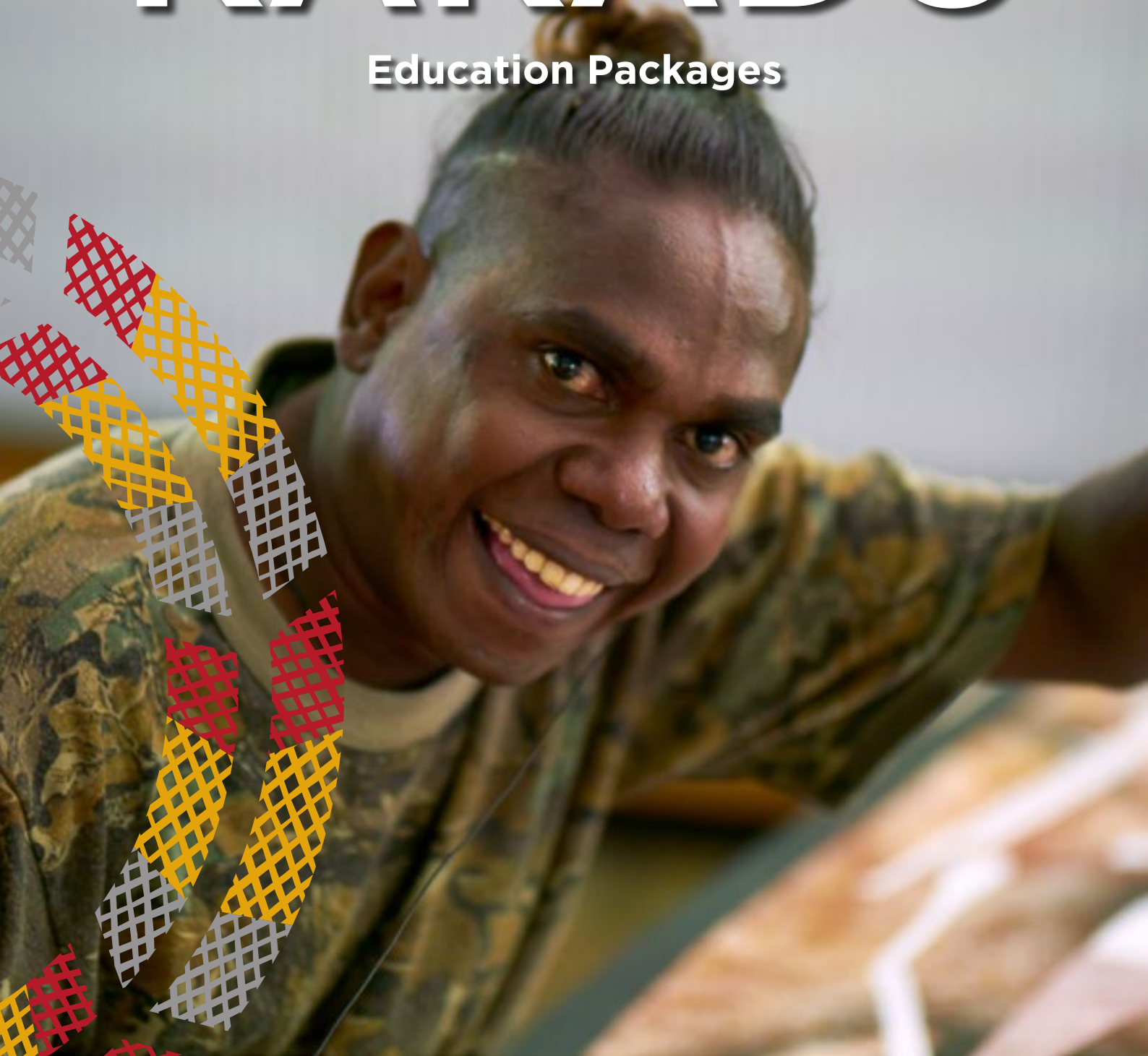

WARRADJAN CULTURAL CENTRE

Spend time with the Traditional Owners of the Murrumburr clan at Warradjan Cultural centre learning to make damper and weave, learn about Kakadu culture from the very people living in Kakadu National Park. Take a walk through the museum on site which has many stories and artefacts of the people of this land. Two hour experience that can include take home weavings and can include morning/ afternoon tea and or packed lunch. All activities are subject to availability at time of booking.





Cooinda Lodge

The village style property is located beneath a canopy of trees beside Yellow Water Billabong, home to world-renowned Yellow Water Cruises, where crocodiles and birds are seen on the flood plain amongst Paperbark, Pandanus and Fresh Water Mangroves.
