The Spirit of Kakadu Adventure Tour runs daily subject to minimum number requirements and explores the southern end of Kakadu National Park. Kakadu's only full-service hotel, the Mercure Kakadu Crocodile Hotel, is located in the township of Jabiru and is ideal for guests exploring the northern end of Kakadu including, Ubirr, Cahills Crossing, Nourlangie Rock Art Site and the Mamukala Wetlands. It is also a perfect spot for hopping on day tours to Arnhemland.

Built in the shape of a crocodile, the hotel pool is the "heart" of the crocodile and the perfect place to relax after a long day of exploring.

Enjoy drinks and a wide range of dishes, including Top End game produce and bush foods, at Escarpment Restaurant and Bar. There's also the onsite Ochre Gallery, where you can view and purchase high-quality local art and crafts.

Developed by the traditional owners, the cultural centre has a variety of displays and artefacts to illustrate the local history and traditions of the area.

Warradjan is also a haven for local Indigenous artists to work on their painting and weaving as well as selling their pieces at the onsite gallery and gift shop.

Warradjan is the indigenous name for the pig nosed turtle and is shaped that way.
